## "The Tecumseh Kids"

Saturday, March 4th date is set for the annual "Tecumseh Kids" Hands-On Day at the range. I have been advised that around 35 students will attend. This means that we will need 35 Red Brush members to act as instructors for the students. The students have completed a "Hunter's Education" class and are ready to practice shooting .22 caliber pistols and rifles. They are also eager to try out the shotguns at clay birds and balloons. The instructors need to be at the range by 8:00 AM, as the class will arrive around 8:30 AM. Both groups will listen to a pre-shooting safety message about their responsibilities. I will divide them into three groups for each of the sessions. Eye and ear protection is mandatory for all participants, including instructors. Bring extra eye and hearing protection if you have it. Instructors are asked to bring extra .22 caliber pistols and rifles for the students to use. Ammo and targets will be provided. Dress appropriately to project a good image of Red Brush Rifle Range.

The more firearms available give the students a wider variation of choice. Ammo and targets will be provided.
