Attendance is projected to be around 100 shooters, with plans to bring in about 30 instructors. The only bay open for non-Appleseed shooters will be the 100-yard Pistol Bay 4. For deer-hunters, **this is the opening weekend of deer season**, but you'll presumably have your rifle/shotgun sighted in before opening day, right?

And for anyone who isn't out hunting, you are strongly encouraged to attend the Appleseed shoot. This is two days of outstanding rifle instruction, intermixed with Revolutionary War history that you never read about in school. And Appleseed is bringing in their "best of the best" master instructors for this event, so it should be even better. Further details will be forthcoming, but we wanted to get the word out for the hunters, so they could make sure they are sighted in before opening day.
