Special Notice:

1. Members, the Board of Directors made a decision at the last regular meeting, April 2nd, to open the range on weekends to the members. The contractor is WAY behind due to the rains and mud and it may be a while longer until the range is operable again. The gate combination has been changed to allow only the contractor or a Board Member access. There are no dirt berms to protect shooters in any of the pistol bays, so we are only allowed to shoot on the 375 yard rifle range. There will be a Range Officer present during shooting hours on the weekends to open and close the gate and to direct members to the proper shooting area. We are asking members to be patient with the construction work that was started to ensure the safety of members going down range between the bays. They are being raised to a higher level after years of settling. You will be notified when all of the construction work is completed and we will be back to normal range operation.
