MEMBERSHIP DUES & WORK DAY OBLIGATION UPDATE

Fellow club members, on March 18, 2009, at a Special Board of Directors meeting, the BOD revisited the Club's fiscal outlook. The Board compared recent expenditures for the acquisition of the range property (\$50,000 plus), much needed berm work (\$41,000 plus) and our yearly operating expenses (approximately \$32,000) to the Club's current financial standing. After much discussion, deliberation and many modified motions the following was decided:

- Yearly dues were set at \$70 per year for those under age 65
- Yearly dues were set at \$50 per year for those over age 65.
- The **WORKDAY EXEMPTION** was raised to age **65**.

The dues increase will be reflected on the 2010 renewal. The workday requirement will take effect in January 2010 with any workday fines payable with the 2011 membership renewal.
