The February Meeting is dedicated to the “auction night” with items that you bring for sale. Food, snacks and beverages, including beer, will be provided for members. The regular business meeting will start at **7:00 P.M.** and last only 15 minutes. There is no Board of Director’s Meeting in Feb.

The auction will begin by selecting items at random from the tables provided. Please bring as much “stuff” as you can carry and label it with **your name** and a reserve price if any. High dollar items **must** be marked with a **minimum price** so that we can move along quickly with the auction.

Items can be anything gun related. It can be new or used. Reloading supplies are great items, cleaning supplies, gun parts, shooting accessories such as scopes and gun cases are good movers. Complete rifles, pistols, and shotguns do sell, but not at high prices. Everyone is looking for a bargain and sellers are getting rid of unwanted items at the same time. We will continue the auction as long as there are items and bidders.

The American Legion will open at 6:00 P.M. for members to set up their items on the tables.

Auction night Guns: There will be four great guns for auction night. One is a bonus prize, which can only be won with a bonus prize ticket. Bonus prize tickets cannot be purchased separately. A bonus prize ticket is included free with the purchase of a \$30 auction night ticket package. The ticket package has three gun raffle tickets and one bonus prize ticket. So it is possible for one person to win all four guns. You may purchase multiple packages if you desire.
