FROM THE RANGE OFFICER – FRANK FINDLEY

BAY 10 CLOSED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

During a safety check we found that rounds fired on Bay 10 which do not directly impact into the back berm could escape. Out of an abundance of caution, we are closing Bay 10 until this situation is remedied.

As a reminder, regardless of which bay you are using, please set your targets at a height such that the rounds will directly impact the back berm. This minimizes chances of ricochet.

PARTIAL RANGE SHUT DOWN UPDATE

Due to conditions, the construction of the much-anticipated shelters for Bays 6 through 10 did not complete in the time period originally planned. Hopefully by the time you are reading this, it has been finished. If not, please be aware that the construction will continue to take place as the weather permits. While the construction teams are present only Pistol Bays 1, 2 and the 400 Yard Rifle Bay will be open for member use. Barrels will be placed to stop traffic from going beyond Bay 2. Please do not enter the cordoned off area during times of construction. It is a safety issue not only for yourself but the workers.

EXPLODING TARGETS ARE NOW BANNED OUTSIDE OF BOARD SANCTIONED EVENTS

The use of exploding targets such as Tannerite® is no longer allowed on the range without explicit board approval. Lesser amounts were previously exempted from the general explosives restriction but after several incidents of excessive use a decision was made to remove this exemption.

RANGE RULES UPDATED – PERFECT TIME FOR YOUR YEARLY REVIEW

We ask members to review the range rules at least once a year to refresh our memories and be up-to-date with any changes. With several important updates just posted to redbrush.org, now is the perfect time to do that.

WINTER CLOTHING CAN MAKE MANIPULATING FIREARMS MORE DIFFICULT

With wintry weather comes layered clothing that can make firearms harder to use. Gloves can make it difficult to hold onto firearms and control trigger squeeze. Bulky coats can make it difficult to remove handguns from holsters and to keep longarms properly shouldered. Scarves and other loose items can get caught in firearm actions. Glasses can fog up lessoning vision. So please be aware of these hazards and take your time to ensure safe handling.

CONSIDER PUTTING CONTACT INFORMATION IN YOUR GUN/EQUIPMENT CASES

It would be helpful if you placed your name/contact information in your gun and equipment cases. This way if they are left at the range, we will be able to more quickly reunite you with the missing items.

REMINDER: LEAVE THE BATHROOM HEATERS ON AND DOORS CLOSED

The bathroom heaters have been turned on to prevent the water lines from freezing. Please do not turn them off. Also, please take a minute to make sure the doors to the bathroom are closed. These electric heaters are expensive to run and cannot protect the water lines from freezing if a door is left open.
