Red Brush Rifle Range is proud to announce that we are hosting the TriState Tactical Two-Gun Match on November 16, 2019.

This is a centerfire rifle and pistol competition with a fast-paced, physically demanding 5-stage event. Two rifle, three pistol. Between each stage there will be a short but physically demanding obstacle designed to elevate your heart rate.

Due to the intensity of the match, there will only be 75 slots available. Registration is \$25. Early registration is suggested and will be available through PractiScore. Regular registration begins September 11.

RED BRUSH PRECISION RIFLE CHALLENGE – AUG 25, 2019

Construction of the new 500 yard shelter is complete and it will be utilized on August 25th for our first precision rifle match of the 2019/2020 season! We already have 60+ shooters registered for this match and it will be the largest precision rifle match to date at Red Brush.



Precision Rifle is a competition that seeks to find a balance between speed and precision. Shooting distances can vary from between 10 and 510 yards, and thus the competitor needs to have good knowledge of their firearms ballistics. The primary focus is on long range shooting, and a competition usually consists of 8-10 stages of fire. Each stage has a set maximum time (par time), and the shooter is awarded points according to how many targets they manage to hit during that time. Targets used are static and reactive steel, and the targets presented are usually relatively small, ranging from 1/2-3 MOA. During a typical match, you'll find yourself shooting from multiple positions, including prone, resting on barricades, tank traps, spools, pipes, rooftops, etc. An average stage is 8-10 rounds, so bolt action rifles with detachable box magazines are the most common firearms used. The rifle should be equipped with a scope that has exposed turrets for fast dialing of DOPE for engaging targets at multiple distances.
