

2020 ANNUAL CLUB DUES

Members, this year we are going to try something other gun clubs in the area are currently doing. Invoicing for your 2020 Annual dues of \$100 (plus a non-workday fine of \$75.00) will be sent to all members via EMAIL. This will eliminate a large amount of money spent on paper, envelopes, and postage each year. It also will reduce the workload of many people handling the physical letter of folding, envelope stuffing, placing the postage, sealing, and delivering 1300 letters pre-sorted into zip codes as required by the U.S. Post Office. There is also the aggravation of lost mail, undelivered mail and address mistakes.

There are also minor problems with email, but not as much as in the physical mailing of the invoice. I am aware that there are members who do not have an email address. In that situation, I will send a physical paper invoice to them. The invoices will be sent the later part of October and or early November. If you have not received an invoice for your 2020 Red Brush Rifle Range dues by mid-November, please contact me at 812-490-0949. This notice will appear in the October and November Newsletter. Included with the invoice will be a copy of the Red Brush "Release of Liability". We are required to maintain a copy per our By-Laws, and many have disappeared through the years due to storage problems. We will now store these forms digitally on a computer once we have received them.

When you receive the invoice via email, please print it along with the "Release of Liability", attach your "proof of NRA membership" (Life Members need not send proof) with your payment and mail it to: Red Brush Rifle Range, Inc., P.O. BOX 422, Newburgh, IN, 47629-0422.

To continue your membership, I MUST receive 1. The Invoice. 2. The Release of Liability. 3. Proof of NRA (except Life Members). 4. PAYMENT of Dues.

FREE STOP THE BLEED TRAINING - NOVEMBER 23 2 PM

Red Brush will be hosting a 45 minute Stop the Bleed training session in the members room on November 23 at 2 PM.

Stop the Bleed is a nationwide campaign designed to empower individuals to act quickly and save lives. A person with serious bleeding from a penetrating injury can die from blood loss within 5 minutes.

No matter how rapid the arrival of EMS, bystanders will always be first on scene. Research has shown that bystanders, with little or no medical training, can become heroic lifesavers. Similar to the use of CPR or automatic defibrillators, improving public awareness about how to stop severe bleeding can be the difference between life and death for an injured person.

Stop the Bleed promotes proper bleeding control techniques, including how to use direct pressure, dressings, and tourniquets. The training consists of approximately 20 minutes of PowerPoint training followed by hands-on skill stations. Lu Weil, Injury Prevention Coordinator at Deaconess Regional Trauma Center, will be conducting the session.

We have space for 15 individuals to attend this first class. If you are interested, please email or call me and I will add you to the list.

REMINDER: CHANGE TO GATE PRACTICES DURING MATCHES & EVENTS

In response to non-members entering the range, modifications have been made to our gate process for matches and events. A monitor will be checking that those entering are either there for the match/event or are a member. So please have your gate card handy to show the monitor.

USE TARGET STANDS APPROPRIATELY! STEEL PLATES NOT RATED FOR PISTOL/RIFLE ROUNDS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE TARGETS!

In September 2018 we reported an injury that occurred at the range from a ricochet off one of our A-frame target stands. The bullet impacted the crossbar of the stand resulting in a small fragment of the bullet returning and hitting the shooter.



At that time, we reminded members to please practice safe stand usage to minimize the chance of stray impacts. This included: posting targets well above the crossbar (including not placing items directly on A-frame), staggering stand placement so one isn't directly behind the other and making sure your finger is off the trigger when your sights aren't on the target.

FROM THE RANGE OFFICER, cont...

Several members recently reported a blatant violation of this. One of the A-frame stands was inappropriately used to hold a thin steel sheet as a target.



As can be seen in the photo, there appear to have been several impacts to the crossbar. Not only does this lesson the life of the target stand, it is dangerous. Furthermore, non-bullet rated steel should not be shot at the range. As written in the range rules:

"If you bring your own steel targets to use, make sure that they are designed for the caliber you are using."

Non-bullet rated steel items are classified as 'junk' by the rules and are banned because they can cause damage to maintenance equipment and also cause injury when left. The jagged plate and steel pieces left behind in this case could have easily done this. Any member found abusing target stands in this manner or shooting similar junk will be subject to fines for damages caused and be subject to suspension.
