NEW YEAR MEANS TIME TO REVIEW THE RANGE RULES & REGULATIONS

Every member is responsible for reviewing the *Range Rules and Regulations* at least once a year. We have made considerable changes to the range and the range rules throughout 2019. This includes revisions to our explosives policy, changes to firearm and cartridge restrictions on certain bays, addition of down-range warning system on the 400-yard bay, and special rules for leagues that enable shooting from the new elevated platforms on the 500-yard bay.

These updated range rules are posted on the Red Brush website so please download them and make some time to review.

Red Brush Rifle Range Annual Auction Night Thursday, February 20, 2020, 6:30 PM

This event is for Red Brush Members, their family or guest. Not open to the general public.

Located at the Evansville National Guard Armory – 3300 Division Street.

Doors will open at 5:00 PM for unloading your Merchandise. Members bring unwanted shooting sport related items to sell. Guns, gun parts, ammo, reloading supplies, dies, gun cabinets, knives, scopes, gun books, stocks, magazines, holsters, pouches, and military items are some of the articles that typically show up. Partial boxes of bullets and powder are also popular. Cheap stuff sales quickly --- somebody out there needs your scope cover, your clips and all those extra springs and gun screws.

Members always find some real good deals; so, bring some cash. There is no commission. All we do is find a buyer for the seller. Don't worry, if you cannot use your bargain purchase, just bring it back next year to sell.

Free Food & Drinks Starting between 5:30 and 6:00 PM. Free Door Prize Tickets. It is your chance to win some great prizes just for showing up. Half pot drawing. Last year the pot paid out \$822.00. Donations of \$5.00 per ticket or three tickets for \$10.00.

There is something new this year. In addition to the live auction for your more expensive items such as firearms there will be silent auction tables for your less expensive items. You place a bidder card with your item that has your name and a minimum price if you have one. Bidders will have a determined time to bid and rebid. At the designated time the silent auction is closed, and the high bidder wins and pays the owner.

You may place any item of any price on the silent auction table. It will be mandatory that the following goes on the silent auction tables: Brass, Bullets, Dies, Magazines, Cleaning Supplies, Knives and any item or combination of items worth than \$50.00 or less. Bidder's card will be available at the Auction or you may print your own attached below.

Thanks to Tactical Mitigation (Randall Hansen), we are able to offer an unprecedented number of guns and choices to the winners. Eight (8) guns this year and a ticket packet is only a \$50 donation. TWO ARE BONUS GUNS. Get a ticket pack and you will get 7 tickets. The seventh ticket is for the bonus gun and is in a separate drawing. Reserved selling prices are no fun but are understandable for expensive items. If you place a reserve price on an item, the auctioneer must know it. On a piece of paper write "Reserve Price" and the amount.

Bring some extra cash in \$1, \$5, \$10 and \$20 for many low-cost items you may purchase.

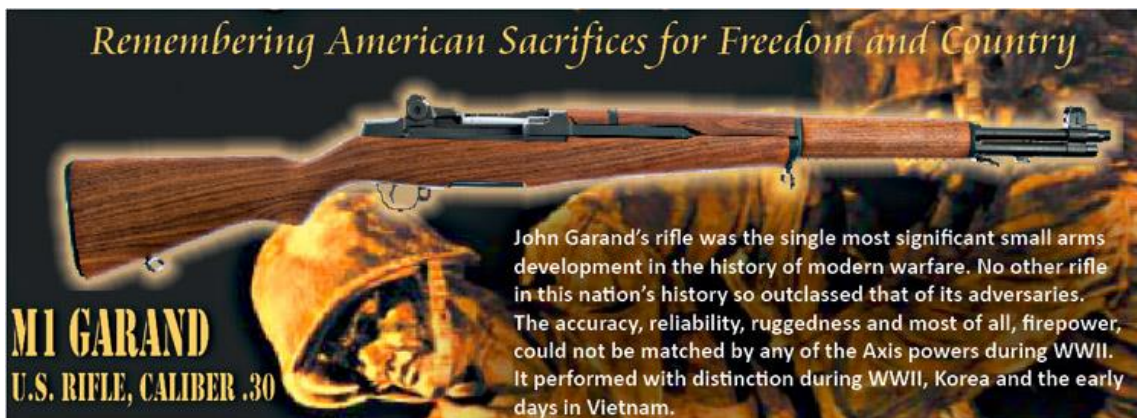
